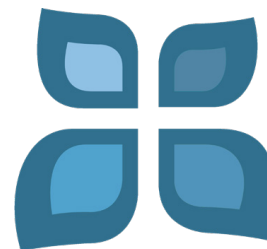

May 5 - 7 | Fall River, KS

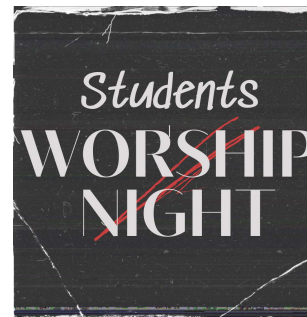
This is an opportunity for men to get away from their day to day lives, spend time surrounded by nature enjoying fellowship with others, and devoting time with the Lord.
