

The goal of the counseling & discipleship ministry is to foster spiritual and emotional transformation by building high joy environments, creating belonging, connecting hurting people to Jesus, and encouraging a culture of honesty and safe vulnerability. At the heart of this ministry are three Life Model Works-based 12 week classes called Restarting (finding healing and joy for life's hurts and painful relationships); Forming (learning to engage God at a level deep enough for transformation); and Belonging (creating joy around ourselves that draws others into healthy relationships with us).
